

Meeting called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Jim Keepers. Minutes of previous meeting were approved.

The GretnaLife Community Expo is March 21 from 9:00 a.m. until Noon at the Middle School. We have requested a booth in the area we were in last year. We may have a single or double sized booth.

The 15<sup>th</sup> annual Gretna Tree Talk will be held on March 28 at Thomas Elementary; starting at 8:00 a.m. Jim has speakers Jan Riegenbach, Rachel Anderson and Bob Hendrickson for presenters. Missy will prepare a poster and bookmark, we will attach packs of seeds to the bookmarks. Jerry and Missy will coordinate printing the program posters. Amy will gather refreshments, and John will coordinate the video systems. We agreed to compensate speakers \$50 each plus mileage.

Tree City USA awards will be April 9<sup>th</sup> in Ogallala, and April 16<sup>th</sup> in Norfolk.

The poster contest for 5<sup>th</sup> graders will have a theme for 2020 of "Plant Trees for Healthy Life" We have sponsors for each school and award winners. Judging will take place on April 15<sup>th</sup>, 5 p.m. at the library. The awards are 4/23/2020, Thursday evening at Thomas Elementary. Missy is working with the art teachers and a poster with sponsor's business logos. Missy will complete the award letters after judging and Marshall will deliver to the schools.

Arbor Day 2020, Friday April 24<sup>th</sup>, will be held at Gretna Elementary at 2:00 p.m.

The Gretna Days Parade for 2020 will be July 25<sup>th</sup>, as it is the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the event we will plan to enter a float for that day.

Jim has submitted the application for the NRD grant, to plant trees at Leo Royal Park. He has pre-ordered the trees in February to make sure we get the species desired.

Upcoming events this summer include the Field Day at Ashland on August 13 & 14, and the Tree Giveaway will be September 12<sup>th</sup>.
