Upcoming Open Houses on Two City Projects

The City of Gretna is planning two open houses to present preliminary plans and receive input for two major projects for the City.

First of all, a City Committee has started mapping out a master plan for the east one-half of the Fields at Gretna. One of the City Council's goals is to build a new aquatic center in a few years, but before that step is taken, the City needs to determine the best location along with other functions for the east portion of the park.

Secondly, a City Committee is in the final stages of developing a streetscape design for our downtown. When the preliminary design is completed, an open house will take place to request comments for the public on the plan. This is one of the immediate goals of the City Council, therefore, from this downtown plan, specifications and design drawings will be completed so that the project can be bid and work commence this year.
