

A message from the Library:

The Library Board of Trustees and I would like to update the Gretna community on the operational status of the Library, and share information about the services we are currently offering.

At this time, we do not have a date for when we will be able to safely open Library doors. Due to the small size of our facilities it is very difficult to practice social distancing safely.

The current circumstances of this pandemic have forced us all to rethink how we can serve community members outside of our doors. In June, we began offering a safe, contactless, curbside pickup service for our patrons. We continue to increase the days and hours that we offer this service.

We have also continued to offer an increased number of digital resources and programs. This will continue, especially with school getting ready to start back up this month. We are already working hard to find out what the Library can do to help supplement resources that may be needed to assist students this year.

We want to say thank you to the Gretna community for all of the wonderfully kind words and support since closing the Library on March 16th . We have been overwhelmed by the kindness everyone has shown the Library and our staff! We are so thankful to serve a community that embraces its library and understands its value!
